



There is no intended interchange exit; previous attempt to consider such effort was denied by authorities.




Why not build a new high school instead of elementary school?







Current district capacity: approximately 75%



Liberty Park Elementary Students: Current Plan vs. Bray Plan








Where is the site of a new elementary school contemplated?





How will construction traffic be managed?

Due to construction sequencing, construction traffic will commence on Liberty Parkway and ultimately be serviced from Sicard Hollow Road as road infrastructure construction advances.



What are the fire and police protection plans for growth and potential entertainment district?

Increased fire and police personnel and equipment efforts have commenced.



Will sidewalks connect The Bray to the rest of Liberty Park?

The LPJV is currently studying connectivity options for sidewalk additions. The Bray will have its own sidewalk paths and trail system.



Will the proposed Bray trail system be publicly accessible?

Yes.



Why are the sidewalks not to be included for City maintenance in the planned infrastructure dedication?

Consistent with the existing maintenance agreement between the City and LPJV, sidewalks will remain "private" to allow use of golf carts on the pathways.



Will the *existing* neighborhood amenities by allowed for use by the new residents of the Bray?

No. The Vestlake HOA and its members will have exclusive use of the existing neighborhood amenities. The Bray development will include a separate set of covenants to include a separate HOA. A joint use amenity package is being developed by the LPJV that will be accessible for both The Bray and Vestlake HOAs.



What cost has the City incurred by hiring special legal counsel?

To-date expenses are \$23,359
