APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 2013 MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Zaragoza made a motion to approve the November minutes. Anne Smyth seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- The National Recreation and Parks Association is partnering with Macy's to make a donation to Wald Park. It's a program whereby local Macy's customers are asked at the time of checkout if they would like to make a donation to a Wald Park. This will run March 7-31. Macy's will match the first \$250,000 raised, dollar-for-dollar. Check distribution by June 2.
- Working with Alabama Forestry Commission to partner with Cahaba Heights Elementary to host a tree giveaway on February 22, 2014 at the school parking lot.

- New Merkel Health Fair committee met to discuss the event of Feb 26.
- Offices have new carpet.
- Wald Park getting new overhead netting.
- Donated 5 free pool passes for upcoming summer to VHEW PTO fundraiser.
- VHPD will be using the Civic Center for SWAT training from 2am-6am on January 16.

MAYORS REPORT

The property for the new city hall building has been purchased and the project is underway. The city is doing well financially.

PUBLIC SERVICES REPORT

Per Brian Davis the ARPA awarded past board member Steve Bendall with the Park Board Member of the Year award at the February 11th banquet at the Hoover Hyatt.

OLD BUSINESS

None.

NEW BUSINESS

FUTSAL Hard Surface Court-

Blaine said there is \$65,000 in grant money available for the construction of a FUTSAL Hard Surface Court but construction costs could run \$150,000. The soccer club needs a designated area to put it and approval from the park board. Per Council President Ammons and Jordy Henson with the foundation a proposal has been received and they will look at the additional funding and continued funding down the road. Blaine asked for a motion from the board to support the FUTSAL Court. Steve's only concern is once the Foundation receives the final TOPO whether the court will fit at the proposed site. The mayor asked what the timeline is. Blaine said approximately early 2015. Blaine said he would sign a resolution, if need be, and Tommy Dazzio offered to help with the grant. Steve wants to discuss the verbiage at the next meeting. After Tommy Coggin looked online, the application deadline is February 1st, 2014, with a second deadline June 1st. Lilla said she got the impression soccer wasn't going to apply until June 1st. It takes 11 months to construct after the grant is awarded. Brian Davis stated that soccer would only need a letter of support from Jason Burnett saying the city owns the land and supports it. A resolution is not needed.

Facility Rental Prices-

After a review of our rental prices the board voted to approve them as they stand for 2014. Blaine asked for a motion to approve the new prices. Tommy Dazzio made a motion to approve. Lilla Hood seconded. The vote was unanimous.

Park Board By-Laws-

Tommy Dazzio previously sent out a marked up version of the by-laws. The changes are ready for approval. Blaine asked for a motion to approve the revised by-laws. Council President Ammons made a motion to approve. Lilla seconded. The vote was unanimous. Blaine asked to be sure the revision date is indicated as January 21st, 2014.

Approval of 2014 Slate of Officers -

Proposed officers are Tommy Dazzio as president and Tommy Coggin as vice president. Blaine opened the floor for any other nominations or recommendations. With no other nominations or recommendations the floor was closed and the slate voted on. Steve Ammons voted to approve the 2014 slate of officers. Lilla Hood seconded. The vote was unanimous.

POOL REPORT

CONCESSION REPORT

Per Trent, his report closes out 2013 with sales up from last year. Sales at Wald Park were down slightly because we didn't have the All Stars. But the numbers keep going up even though we did have a lot of cancelled tournaments last year.

Here are the specific events I have been working on and their respective status:

D1 at the SHAC- It looks like D1 at the SHAC will finally start training by the end of this month. We need a permanent solution to stray lacrosse balls, but for now we have that covered with some clever soccer engineering. Emails go out this week to lacrosse and soccer players, and registration is open for both youth and adult sessions at the SHAC.
