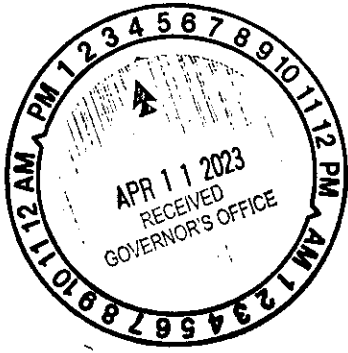

1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 To authorize the governing body of the City of Vestavia
5 Hills, Alabama, pursuant to Amendment No. 373 to the
6 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 217
7 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to increase the rate
8 at which there is levied and collected by the city, on all
9 taxable property situated within the city, the special ad
10 valorem tax for public school purposes authorized in Amendment
11 No. 56 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing
12 as Section 216.04 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to a
13 maximum rate, for any tax year of the city, which is equal to
14 \$3.54 on each one hundred dollars (\$100) (35.4 mills on each
15 dollar) of assessed value.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The following words and phrases have the
18 following meanings:

19 (1) AMENDMENT NO. 56. Amendment No. 56 of the
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
21 216.04 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.

22 (2) AMENDMENT NO. 325. Amendment No. 325 of the
23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 217
24 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.

25 (3) AMENDMENT NO. 373. Amendment No. 373 of the
26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 217
27 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022.

28 (4) CITY. The City of Vestavia Hills.



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29 (5) CITY COUNCIL. The City Council of the City of
30 Vestavia Hills.

31 (6) SPECIAL TAX. The special ad valorem tax for public
32 school purposes authorized in Amendment No. 56 and pursuant to
33 elections held in the City on April 28, 1970; May 8, 1990; and
34 March 11, 2014; and levied and collected on taxable property
35 in the City, being originally levied at the rate of 7.5 mills
36 on each dollar of assessed value and, pursuant to proceedings
37 heretofore taken under Amendment No. 325 and Amendment No.
38 373, presently levied at the rate of 25.6 mills on each dollar
39 of assessed value.

40 Section 2. The City presently levies and collects the
41 Special Tax at a rate of \$2.56 on each one hundred dollars
42 (\$100) (25.6 mills on each dollar) of assessed value. Pursuant
43 to a resolution adopted by the City Council in accordance with
44 Amendment No. 373, the City proposes to increase by 9.8 mills
45 the rate at which it may levy and collect the Special Tax to a
46 maximum rate, for any tax year, which is equal to \$3.54 on
47 each one hundred dollars (\$100) (35.4 mills on each dollar) of
48 assessed value.

49 Section 3. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment No.
50 373, and a resolution adopted by the City Council after a
51 public hearing, the City Council may increase the rate at
52 which the City levies and collects the Special Tax to a
53 maximum rate, for any tax year, which is equal to \$3.54 on
54 each one hundred dollars (\$100) (35.4 mills on each dollar) of
55 assessed value.

56 Section 4. The increase in the rate at which the



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57 Special Tax may be levied and collected pursuant to this act
58 is subject to the approval of a majority of the qualified
59 electors residing in the City who vote on the proposed
60 increase at a special election called and held for that
61 purpose pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment No. 373.

62 Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately
63 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
64 otherwise becoming law.
